The International Library of Children's Literature (ILCL), National Diet Library offers, a loan service of the exhibition titled "The World through Picture Books—Librarians' favourite books from their country."

These books were collected through a project led by the IFLA section Libraries for Children and Young Adults with the aim of making a book set of picture books recommended by librarians from around the world (for details of the project, see http://www.ifla.org/node/6718). As part of the project, two identical sets of books for exhibition were created – one is in the ILCL, and the other is in Bibliothèque nationale de France (BnF). The book set in Japan is available for loan free of charge to libraries in the Asian and Oceanic region.



Terms and conditions

The contents of the exhibition set

- approx. 300 picture books selected by librarians from 36 countries and regions
- a multilingual catalogue "The World Through Picture Books"
- a list of books
- Picture books can be exhibited for free access under monitoring by the staff

Applicant

- National or local government organizations
- Public organizations that wish to hold an exhibition open to the public
- one or two organizations per year

Period

- one month (excluding the period of transportation)

Charge

- Free of charge (the organization borrowing the exhibition must bear the cost of sending it back to Japan)

Transportation

- The exhibition set is packed in five boxes (*)

*Size of each box: 36*50*23cm

Weight of each box: approx. 20kg

- The exhibition set must be sent back via air mail.
- The organization borrowing the exhibition must bear the cost of insurance for the declared value of 6,000€
