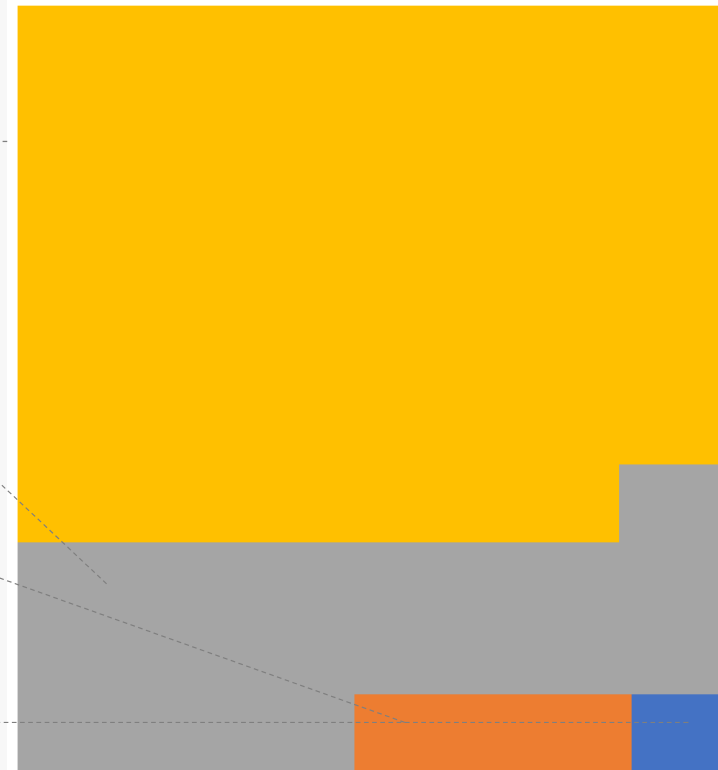
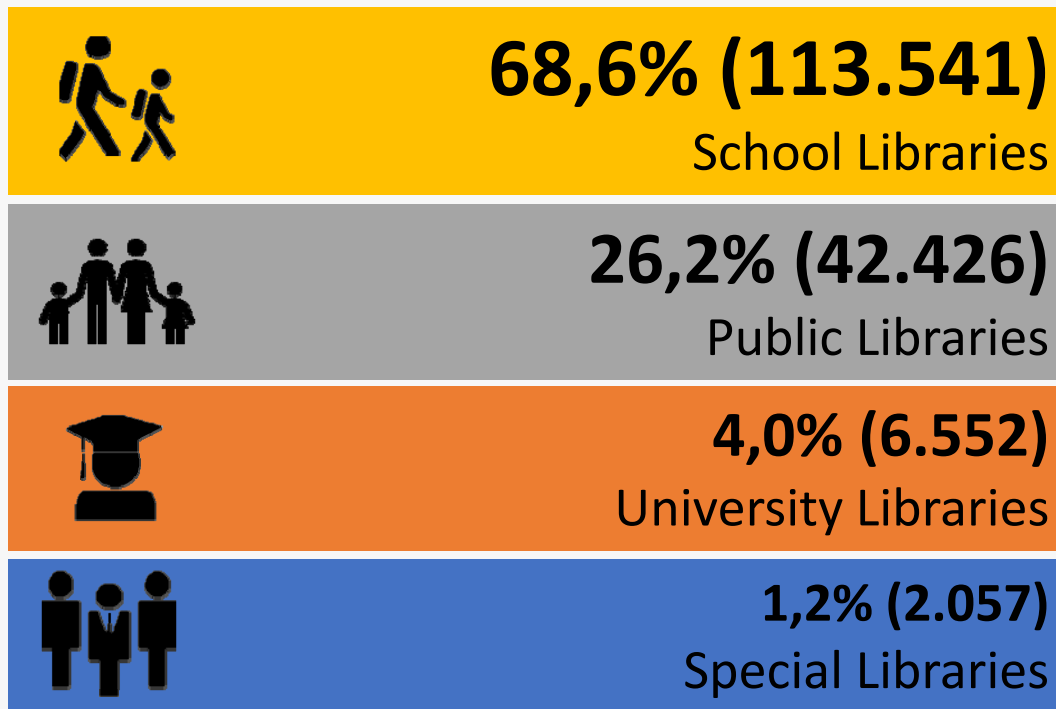
The Uniqueness of National Library of Indonesia

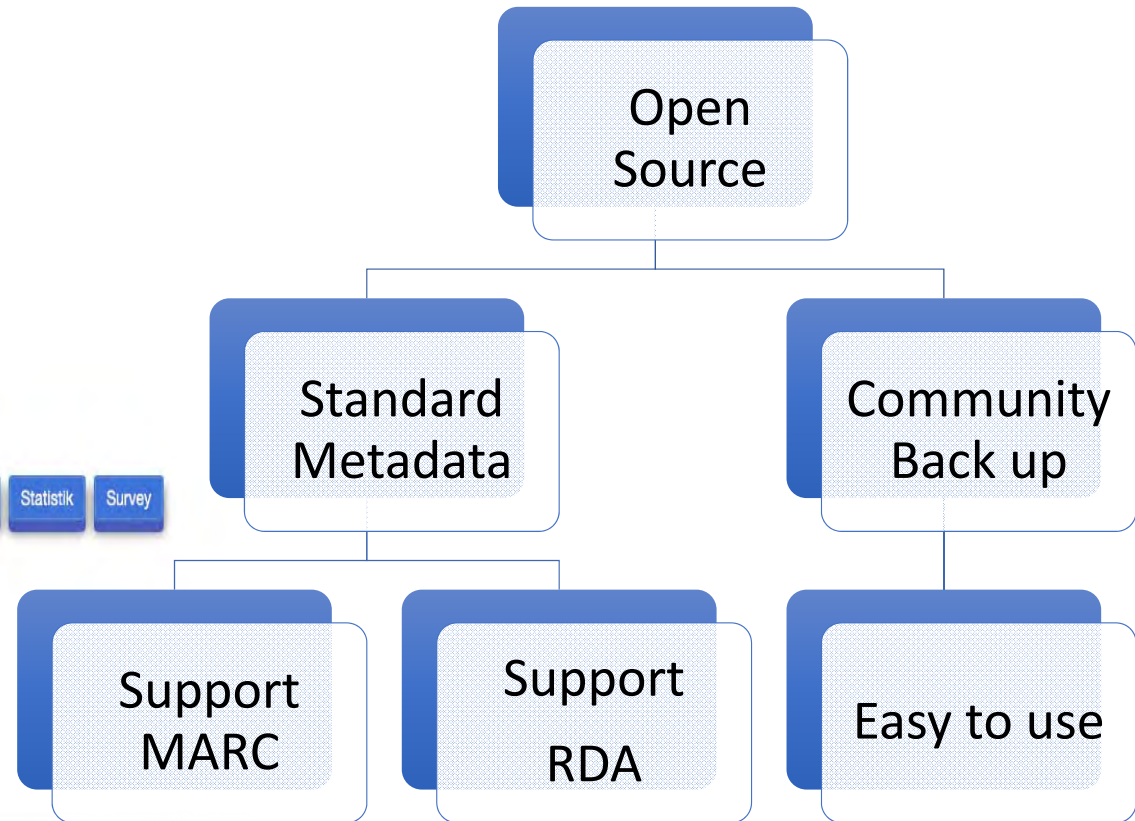
INLIS LITE 3.0

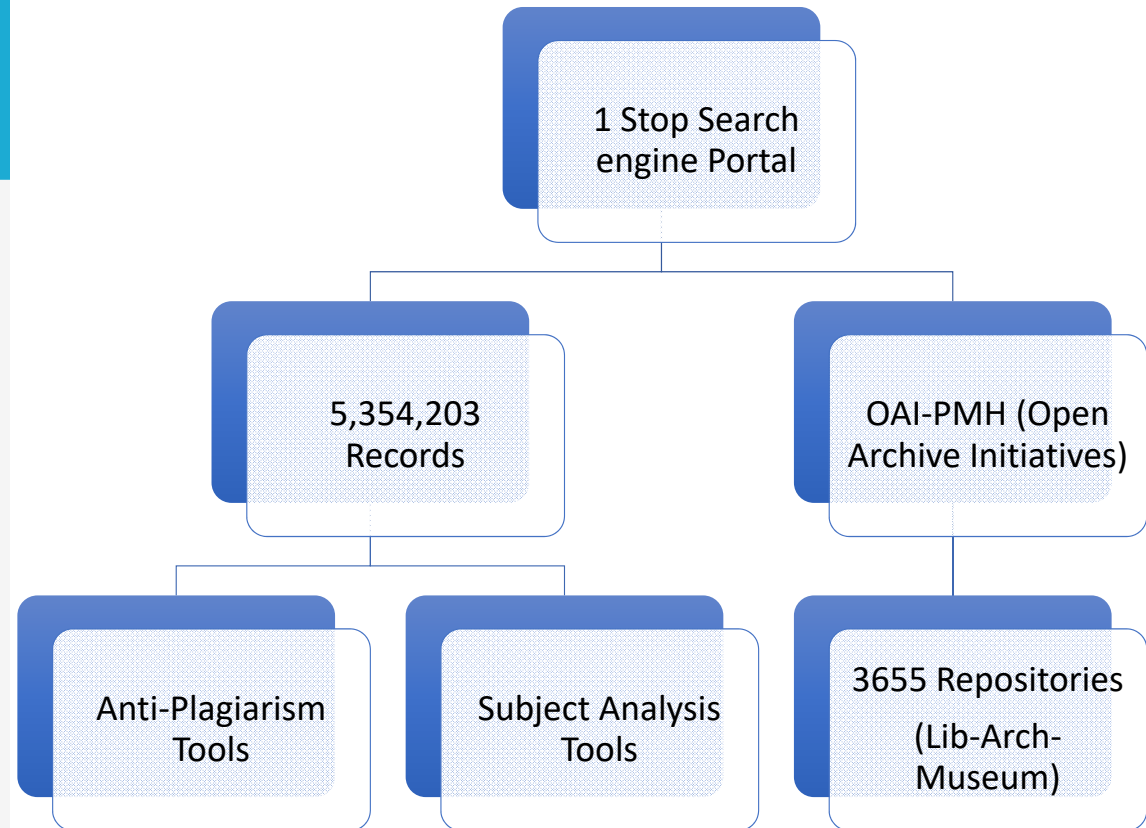

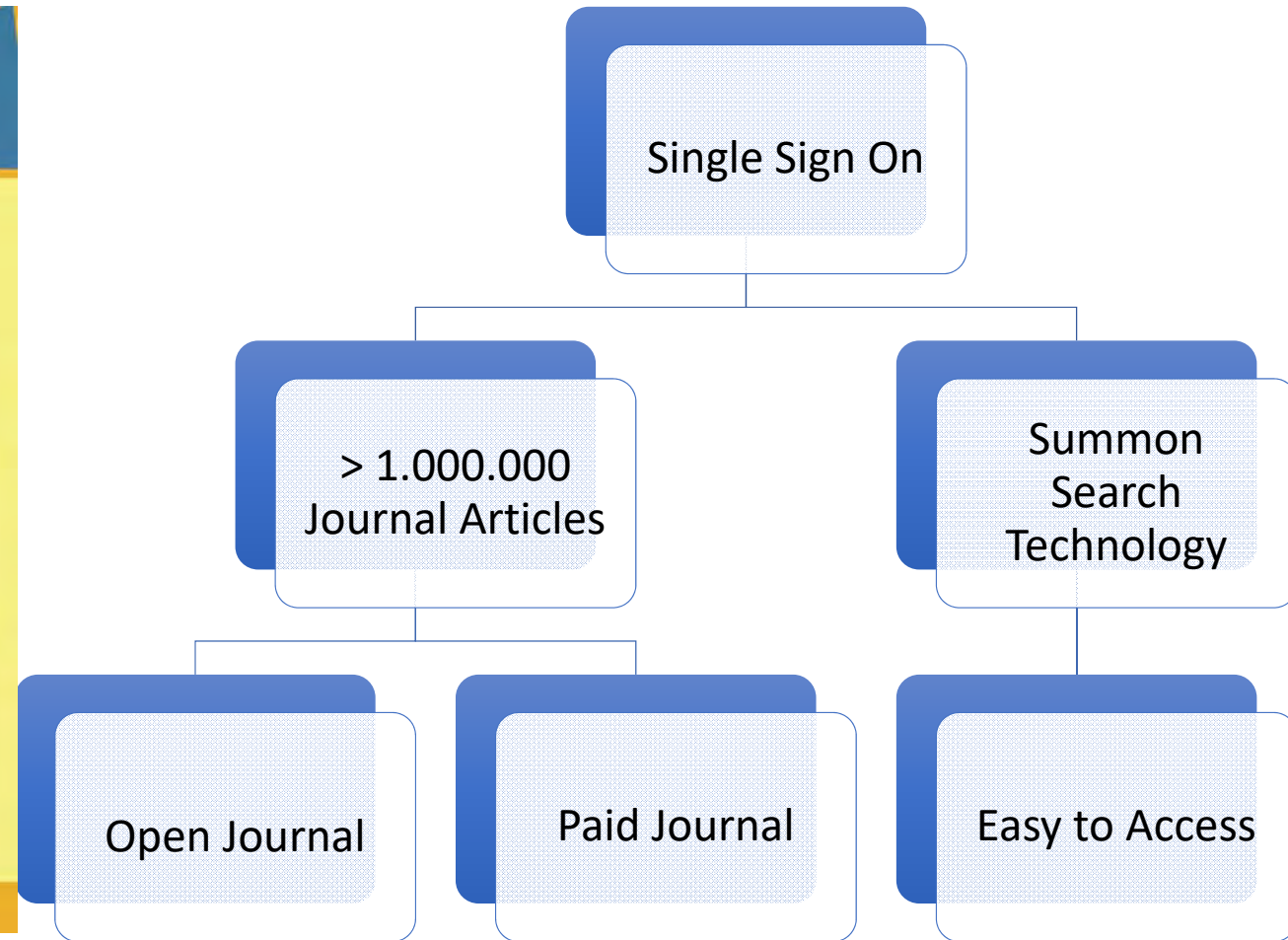

Library transforming Society



The PerpuSeru program is a library development program supported by the National Library of Indonesia, Coca-Cola Foundation Indonesia and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, since November 2011, which aims to make libraries as learning centers and act on information and communication technology-based communities, with the aim of impacting on quality improvement community life. In the first program phase, PerpuSeru partnered with 34 libraries in 16 provinces throughout Indonesia, consisting of 28 district / city libraries, 1 provincial library, 3 village / kelurahan libraries, and also 2 Community Reading Gardens (TBM).



From 2013-2018 Budget Resource came from coca-cola foundation and Bill & Mellinda Gates Foundation, we (National Library of Indonesia) were collaborated with them and Since 2018 the sustainability of this program has fully covered from the budget National Library of Indonesia, in 2018 the budget is US\$1 Million and in 2019 the Government of Indonesia declared that this program is **ONE OF OUR NATIONAL PRIORITY PROGRAM** and funded with US\$ 10 Million budget.

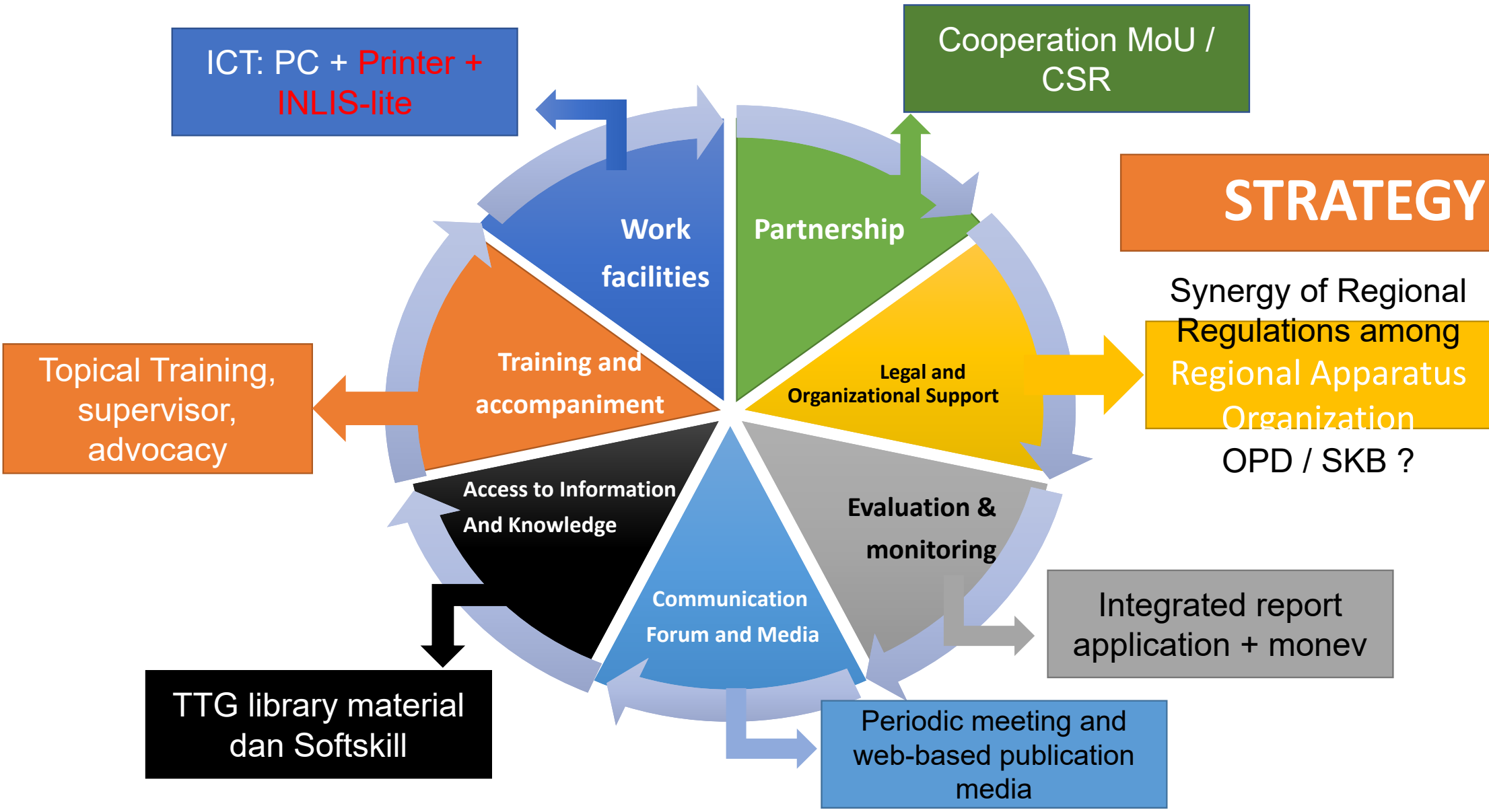

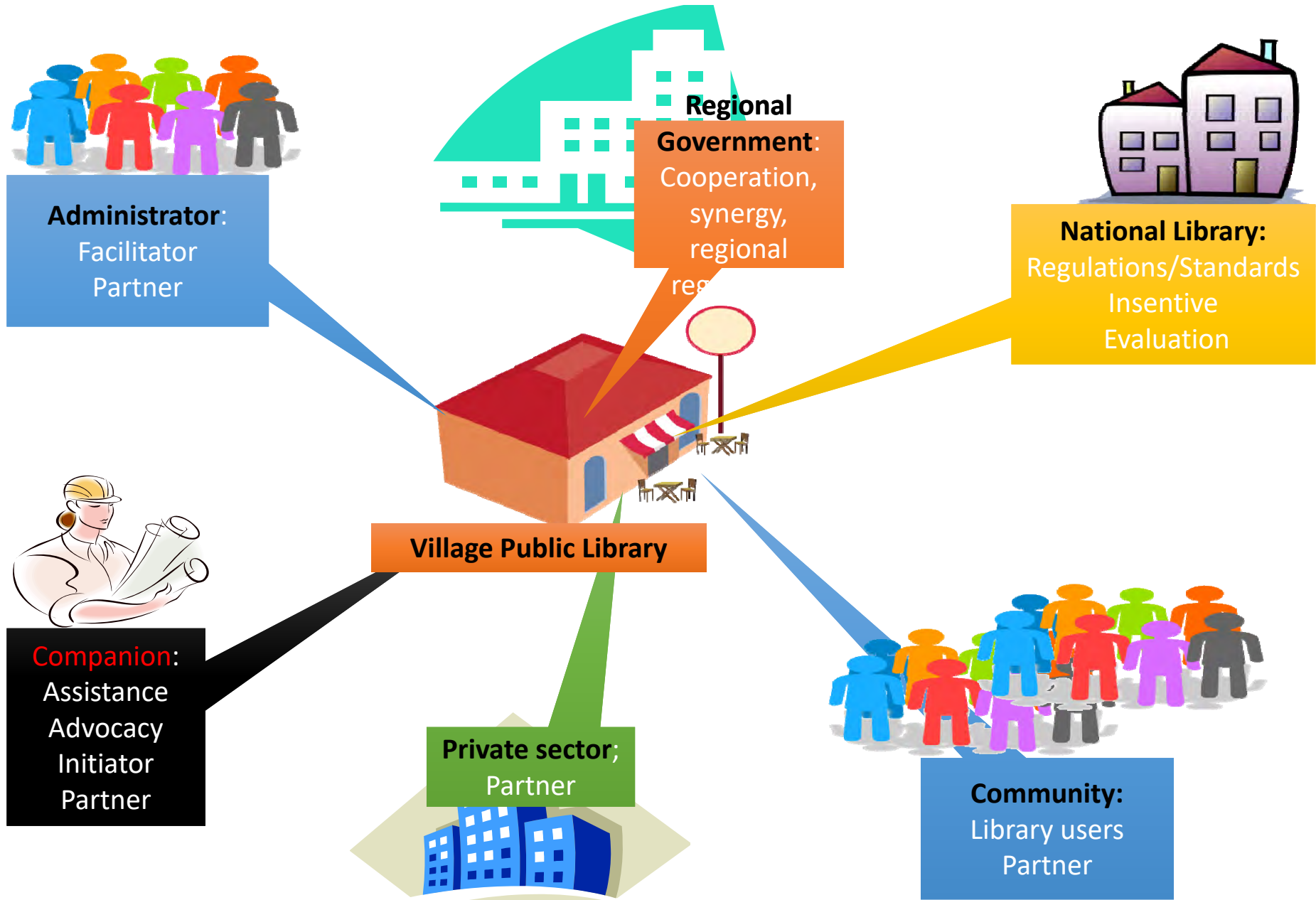

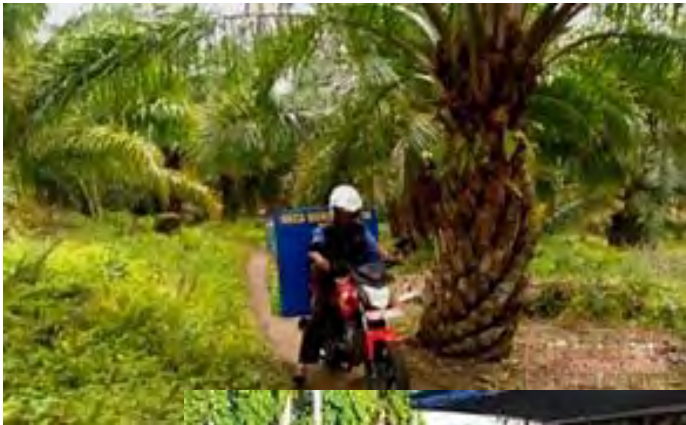

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HOW NATIONAL LIBRARY OF INDONESIA SERVES AS A LEVER IN FACING CHALLENGES IN THE NEXT 40 YEARS

New Strategy of Advocacy

- National Library of Indonesia's role as a lever in facing challenges, National Library of Indonesia has carried out a number of breakthroughs, for example performing advocacy of policy aspect. We succeeded to convince government through Act No. 23 of the year 2014 concerning regional government in which library is a mandatory issue of every government in both province and regency levels. Through this policy every government in provinces and regencies have to provide adequate facilities and budget for public libraries in their territories.

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WHAT CAN WE DO MORE



- The industry 4.0 and society 5.0 era have changed community mindset about library, National Library of Indonesia is well aware that libraries in Indonesia have to transform not only to be information centre but also community place for dialogue, collaboration and cooperation in order to improve people's welfare.

- launched Mobile Library programme in mobilizing knowledge. We launched this programme so that community can benefit from knowledge in library. This programme has succeeded to attract people to read more and visit library, and train many library officers in Indonesia
- National Library of Indonesia and Ministry of Villages, Development of Disadvantaged Regions and Transmigration have agreed that every village is obliged to provide 5% of village budget given by the government for village library service.

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HOW NATIONAL LIBRARY OF INDONESIA RESPONDS TO BUDGET REDUCTION TREND

- In Indonesia, library budget trend tends to increase and even in 2019, National Library of Indonesia receives budget increase 25% higher than the previous year as well as additional special budget for provincial, regency libraries development as many as \$20 million.

This trend is a result of National Library of Indonesia approach towards information literacy issue in which library greatly contributes to community welfare improvement. A number of strategies performed by National Library of Indonesia:

- Advocacy through law and regulation
- Indonesian government policy at the present time focuses on library because we realize that Human Development Index improvement has to be supported with education and library
- Convincing stakeholders that libraries in Indonesia is an important part in the effort to develop the nation
- Rebranding of library as a place of transformation in community

National Library of Indonesia at the present time may not be the largest and also not the best, but we will continue to improve in the future.
