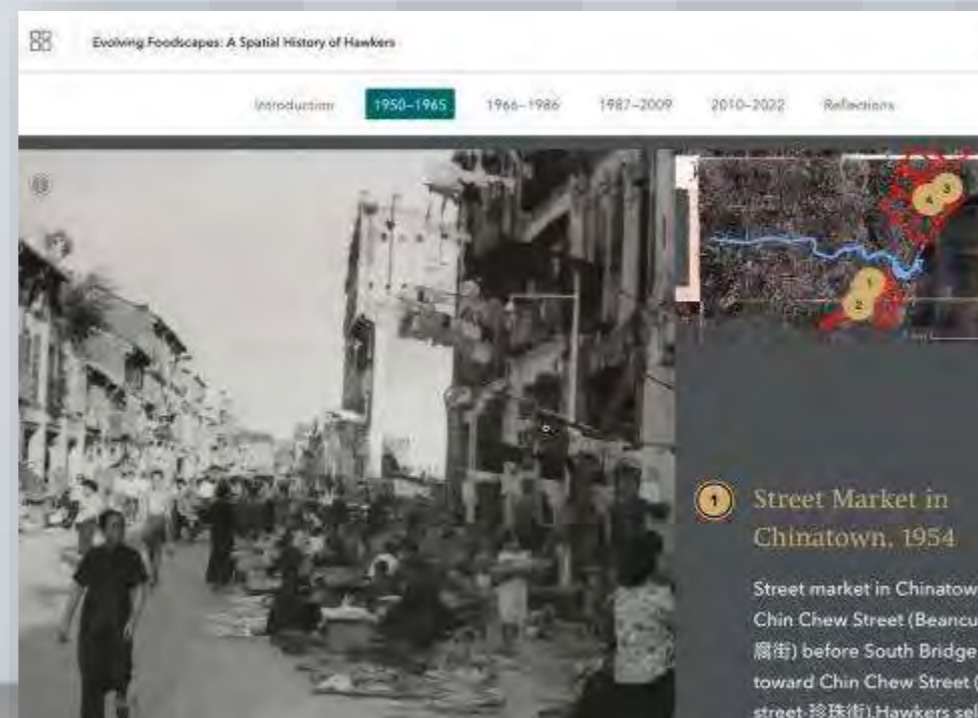

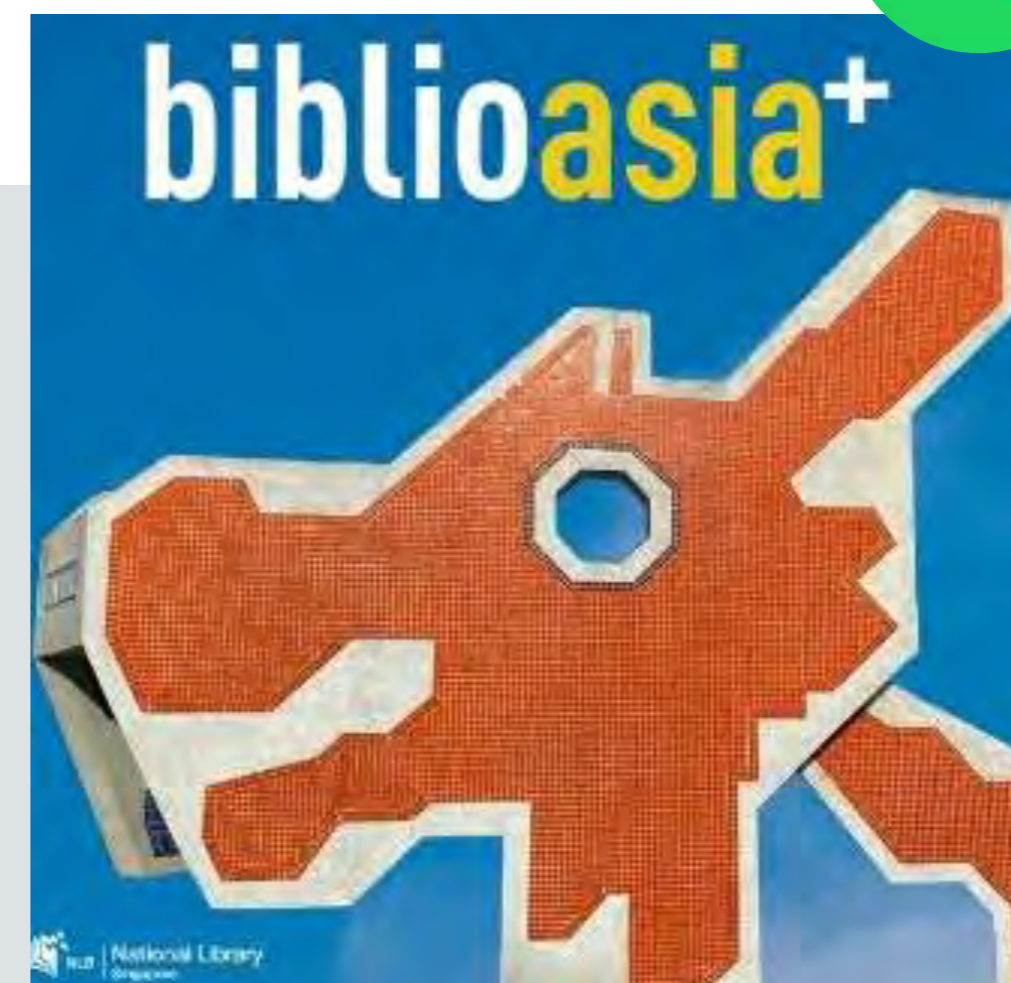

Poets battled it out at a spoken-word poetry competition based on artworks from the library's art collection.

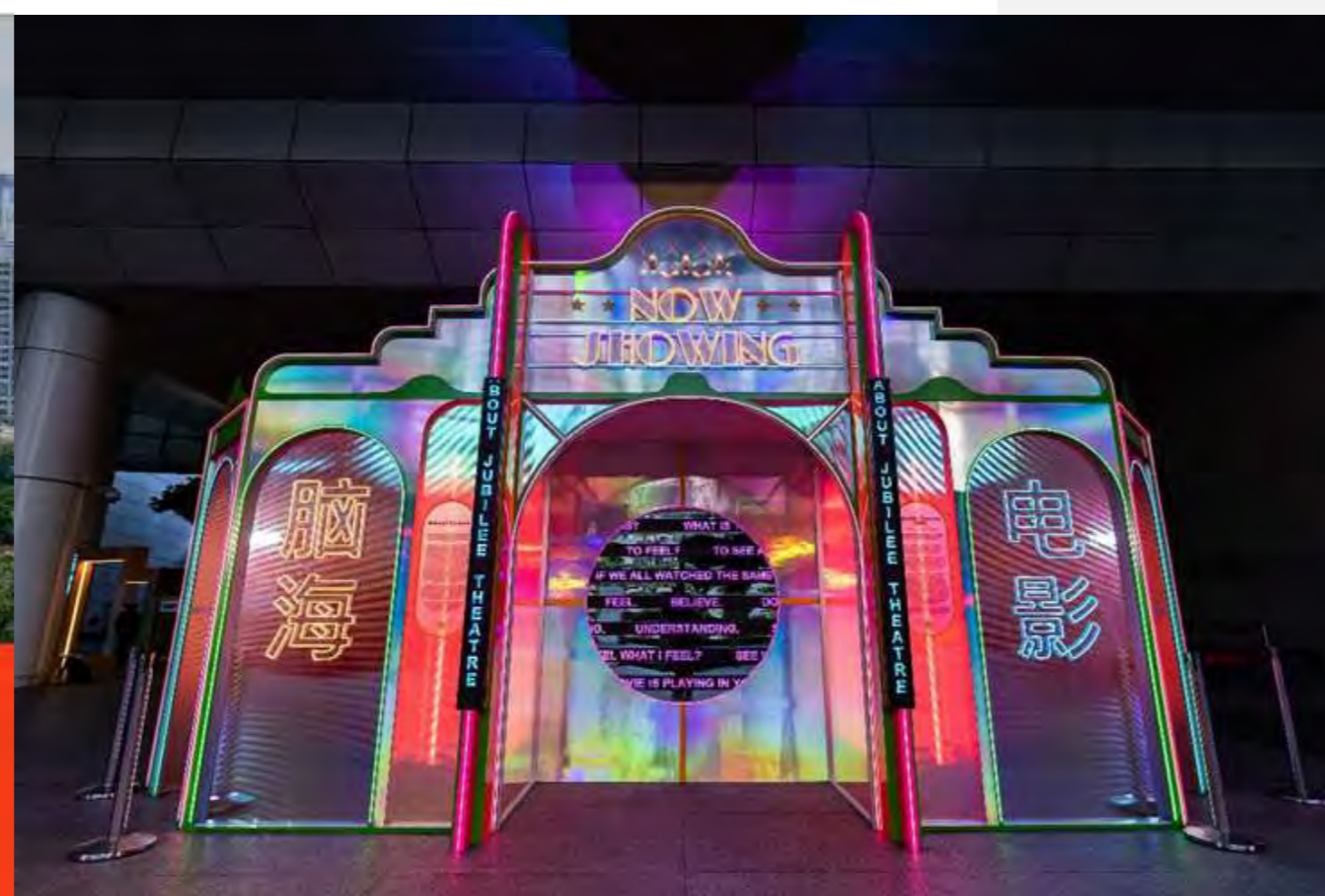




# Experiencing Singapore Stories through space and time

by going beyond online experiences

Started as a website for map-based, placed-related stories, the website was enhanced with new story maps and digital content. Curio city was expanded to include installations through collaborations with major museum festivals.

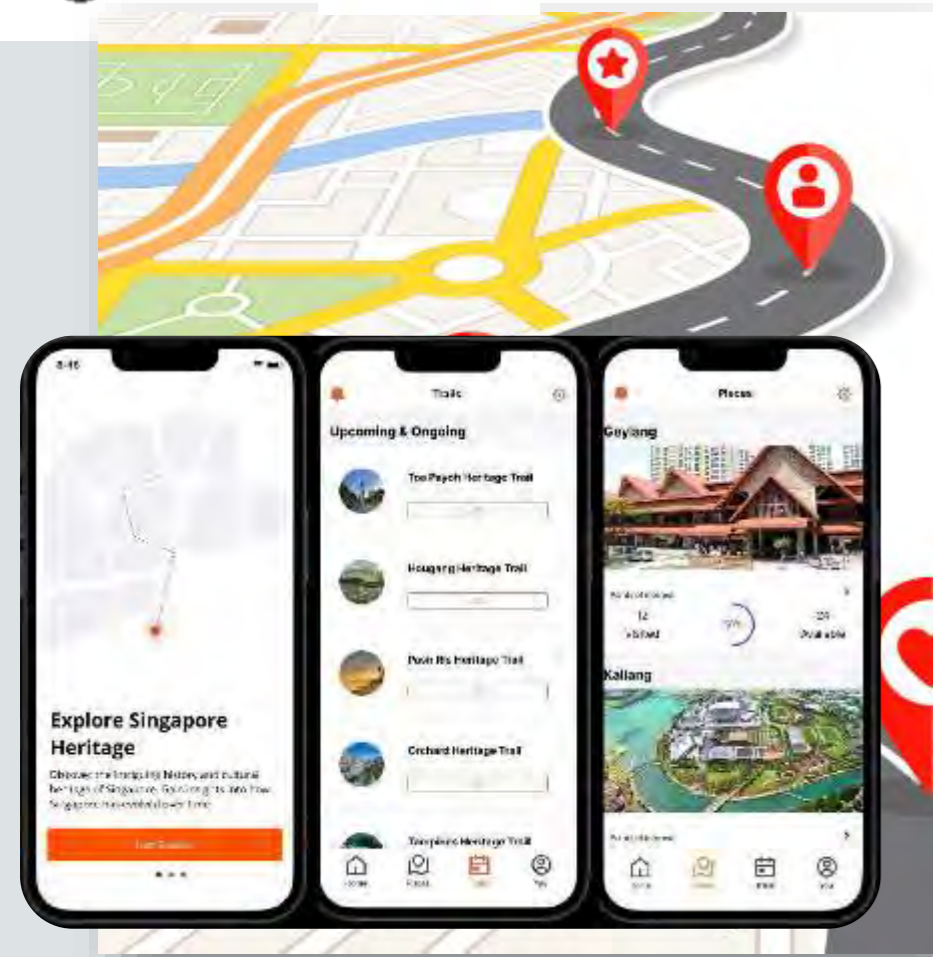
# Experimenting to reach a wider audience

## 1 ( ) EXPLORESG



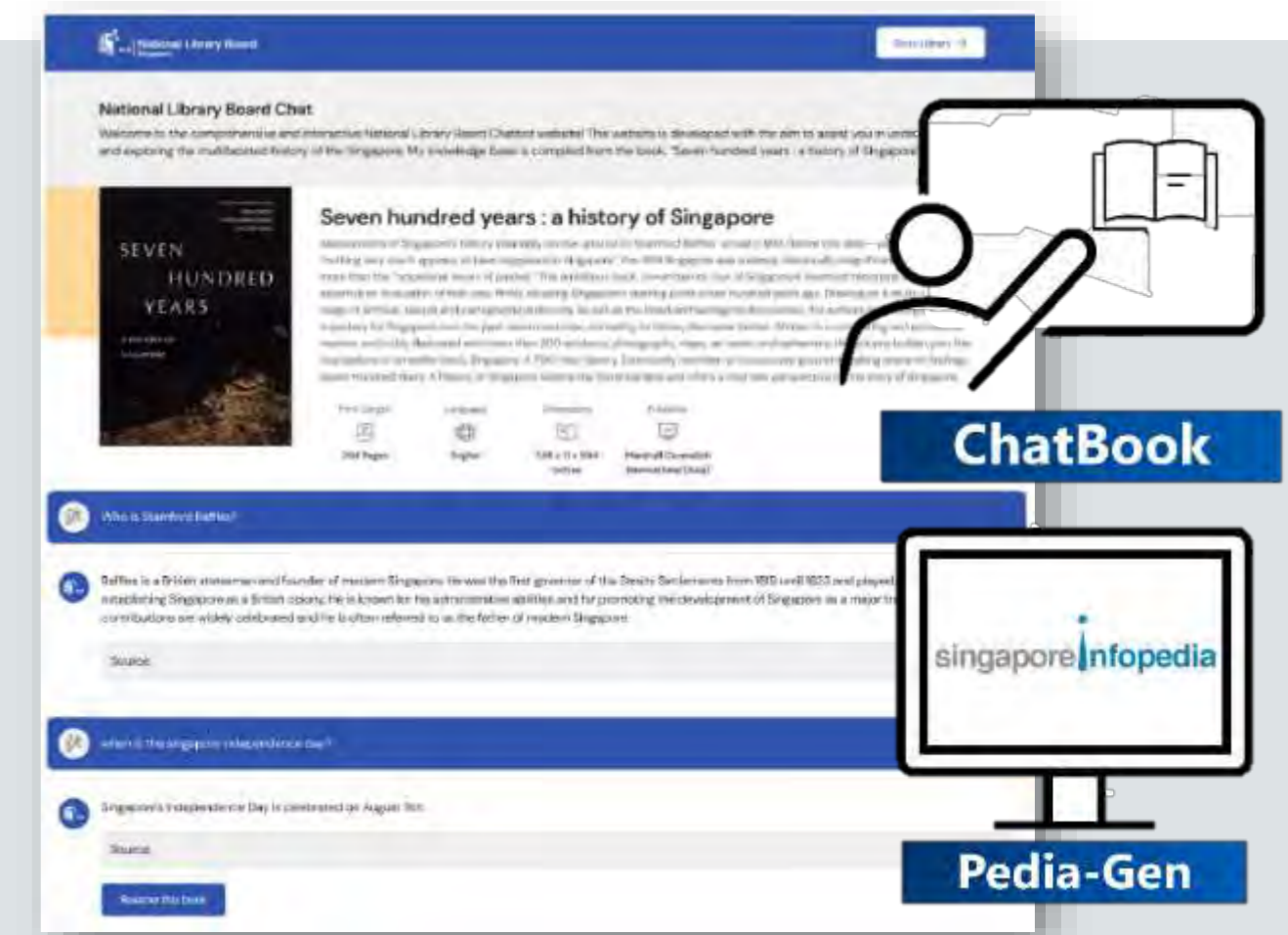
ExploreSG is a webApp for guided tour or school learning journey.
