## Breastfeeding Support Sessions

- The Breastfeeding Support Group first emerged in early 2020 following a breastfeeding campaign that was hosted at the Library in 2018.
- To support pregnant and nursing mothers. Aside from library resources, QNL facilitated free access to lactation specialists.
- First sessions (which were on-site) low attendance. With the pandemic, we went online our attendance grew with Arabic speaking mothers from around the globe.
- Mothers everywhere were struggling to get access to lactation specialists due to the pandemic.
- Despite online fatigue, mothers working or not still preferred the virtual sessions over in-person sessions.
- Aside from breastfeeding support sessions we also have sessions for caring with children with special needs or ADHD targeting both parents and educators.







#### Protecting regional documentary heritage

- In 2015 the QNL Preservation and Conservation Center was selected to be the IFLA PAC Regional Center for Arab countries and the Middle East.
- As a PAC Center, QNL offers the expertise of highly professional international team and world-class conservation facilities.
- We support and assist Arab libraries with conservation issues.
- Produce and publish materials related to preservation and conservation (in Arabic and English) or translate IFLA guidelines
- Guide the development of disaster plans
- Organise courses, workshops and meetings

### **Himaya Project**

- Initiated to counter trafficking of documentary heritage in Middle East, North Africa and Central Asia.
- In collaboration with Qatar National Commission for Education, Culture and Science and international agencies like INTERPOL, inter-governmental UNESCO, NGOs like ICA14 -(EGATTT); ministries and law enforcement agencies and officers in the region.



#### Main areas for this project:

- Advocate for improved laws for documentary heritage protection and for cultural institutions to update the INTERPOL database of stolen works of art.
- Advocate for better catalouging and description of collections
- Capacity building organising workshops and events and importantly a database of contacts and enhancing the network of experts.
- Develop an automatic monitoring and scanning system for illicit sales in auction catalogues and social media and so on.
