Q1	How widely is the Internet spread in your country? Please give us some statistical figures such as the percentage of people who use the Internet and the penetration rate of broadband, if available.				
Australia	<p>The Internet is widely spread in Australia; however there are still some areas of remote and regional Australia with poor connectivity. In early 2009 the Australian Government committed to invest up to \$43 billion over eight years to build and operate a National Broadband Network. This is expected to increase the speed and efficiency of broadband communications for all Australians.</p> <p>The current situation according to the Australian Bureau of Statistics for 2007/8 is:</p> <p>“In 2007-08, 67% of Australian households had home Internet access and 75% of households had access to a computer.</p> <p>In 2007-08, the number of households with a Broadband Internet connection increased by 22% from the previous year, to an estimated 4.3 million households. This represents over half (52%) of all households in Australia and 78% of households who have Internet access. A small proportion of respondents (1%) did not know the type of their internet connection at home.”</p>				
Bhutan	Dail-up internet connection is available in all the 20 Districts of the Country (all the villages with a telephone connection can now connect to internet). Broadband Internet connection is also available in the 16 Districts of the 20 Districts. Statistical figures not available.				
Cambodia	Cambodia is a developing country as you know, but I am afraid the National Library does not have the information to answer these questions for you. It is possible the Ministry of Post and Telecommunications may be able to provide you with data in this area.				
China	The answer: By the report we got from CNNIC (China Internet Network Information Center) in January 2009, by Dec. 31 2008, the persons who use internet in China amounts to 298 million, increased by 41.9% by one year. The number of persons who use broadband amounts to 270 million, 90.6% of the total number of the internet users.
